Purpose :

Name :

The name of the scholarship will be the “ George Washington Carver Scholarship Award “

Criteria :

- I. The nominee should have been a member of the Fraternity for at least **two semesters** of the academic year.
- II. The nominees must have a cumulative GPA of a 3.0 at the time of nomination.
- III. The nominee must demonstrate leadership in some area of nonacademic campus life (President of club or Honor Society , team captain, etc.)
- IV. The nominee should have made a tangible contribution to the growth , development , and maintenance of the Fraternity (reactivation, recruitment, or noteworthy recognition to the Fraternity)
- V. The nominee must type an essay of 500-1500 words to demonstrate his skills in written communication (APA Format) .
- VI. An official transcript must accompany the application and essay.
- VII. Suggested topics for the essay are:
 - ◆ **“Racism in the courtroom / in prisons?”**
 - ◆ **“How has the Afro-American youth changed in recent years?”**
 - ◆ **“Does the American Dream still exist? What does it consist of?”**
 - ◆ **“Are Greek Lettered Organizations still needed in the community?”**
- I. The nominee must be a current financial member .
- II. The recipient must be at the State Conference to give synopsis of his essay. If for any reason the recipient cannot be present , a written reason must be received by the State Director of Education prior to State Conference and approved by State Board.
